





Exploring the Evolution of South Africa's Unemployment Rate








KEY INSIGHTS:

- South Africa's unemployment rate grew by **10.7**% between 2008 & 2022, leaving **34%** of the labour force without work.
- Black Africans have the highest unemployment rate amongst all races at 48% as of April 2022, up from 36% in April 2008.
- Black Africans make up 90% of the unemployed in the labour force, which totals 7.9 Million neonle.
- Gauteng has the highest number of unemployed, at 2.5 Million people.
- KwaZulu-Natal & the Eastern Cape have 1.2 Million and 1 Million unemployed individuals respectively.
